Code of Conduct

All participants are expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct:

- I will participate, as required, in cooperation with other students and leaders.
- I will be responsible for keeping up with my personal items and do my share to prevent littering at Trail Blazer Survival Camp.
- I understand that the possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, or illegal drugs at Trail Blazer Survival Camp is prohibited. This applies to everyone at Trail Blazer Survival Camp.
- I understand that possession of lasers of any type and possession or detonation of fireworks is prohibited.
- I understand that the possession of any firearms or weapons while on Trail Blazer Survival Camp property is strictly prohibited.
- I will keep myself appropriately dressed and presentable in regard to the activity in which I am participating.
- I understand that Trail Blazer Survival School & Adventures staff are not responsible for loss, damage, or theft of personal items.
- I will demonstrate respect for Trail Blazer Survival Camp property and be personally responsible for any loss, damage, or vandalism of property as a result of my actions.
- I will stay on designated trails and stay with my group at all times.
- I will not disturb the plants and wildlife and will safely observe them without touching.
- While participating in activities, I will obey the safety rules and instructions of all teachers, supervisors and staff members.
- I will show respect to instructors and leaders and listen attentively to the lessons.

Trail Blazer Survival School & Adventures Employees and Volunteers are professional and kid friendly, but are not trained in classroom management. The school or organization arranging the activity is responsible for the supervision of their students in respect to maintaining discipline, security, and enforcing the Code of Conduct.
